

# Special Interests

## Handgun License Class

Upon successful completion of this class, students will be able to apply for a Texas Handgun License recognized in 36 states.

Class covers all state required topics, Basic Firearms Safety, Safe Handling and Storage, Non-Violent Dispute Resolution, Use of Force Laws, Civil and Criminal Liability (Texas Law Shield presentation), and Texas Handgun Laws.

All students must successfully complete a written test and live fire qualification. Students should be familiar with their pistol and know how to operate it safely. Accommodations can be made for those needing additional assistance or encouragement.



## Refund Policy

### Cancellation or Rescheduling

Most classes have a minimum number of students in order to be held. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel, combine, change time, date, change instructors or make any revisions, which may be deemed necessary.

## Refund / Transfer Policy

### Recreation Programming


When the Department cancels a class, you may choose to transfer to another class that is not full or receive a full refund. Participants requesting to withdraw or transfer classes must do so fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the start of the original class, providing space is available in the requested class. There will be NO refunds to participants who withdraw within fourteen (14) calendar days. Participants who develop a medical condition that impairs their ability to benefit from a class may request, and be prepared to provide a doctor's note to the Alvin Recreation Department. Credit toward a future recreation program in lieu of a refund is preferred.

### Park Pavilion, Pool Rentals and Passes

Rental fees are required to be paid in full at the time the reservation is made. Patrons requesting to cancel or transfer their prepaid reservation date(s) may do so unless the request occurs within fourteen (14) calendar days of the date of reservation, then a \$25 refund processing fee will apply for changes to the reservation date and/or forfeiture of all or part of the entire fee for cancellation. Full or partial refunds will be considered for rentals canceled by the Parks and Recreation Department due to bad weather, mechanical or chemical problems. Patrons are encouraged to reschedule to another open date in lieu of a refund. Pool passes are non-refundable.

### Types of Refund Methods

Payments made by cash, check, credit card or money order shall be refunded in the form of a check from the City of Alvin payable to the original name making the registration(s) and/or reservation(s) less any applicable refund processing fees AND E-Commerce fee. A \$25 processing fee will apply to refunds.
