Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Update

A Capital Improvement Program, is a multiple-year forecast of the capital needs of the City. This plan provides a planning and financing schedule for capital improvement projects. Capital improvements are projects with long term assets such as roads, buildings, and landfills. Quarterly updates are given on the progress of all CIP projects.

Report a Problem

Media Releases

The City uses media releases to inform the local media of specific events that have happened or about to happen within the city. This is done in an effort to notify the public of the event(s) through the local media. Upon the formal release of the document, this information is also published on the city's website and emailed through GroupBuilder to those who have signed up to receive media releases/press releases.

Financial Information

The City's Financial Information including the annual proposed and adopted budgets along with the annual financial reports can be found on the city's website. The budget process begins in April each year and goes through the summer. The finalized budget is typically adopted in September and takes effect in October. The City's fiscal year runs from October-September.

BIDDING INFORMATION

State law requires that any purchase the City makes over \$50,000 must go out for competitive bidding. Bidding information is compiled and published in the Alvin Sun Newspaper for two (2) consecutive weeks. This information is also published on the City's website.

The City may satisfy the competitive bid requirement by purchasing goods and services through cooperative purchasing programs. BuyBoard, The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS), and Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) are cooperative purchasing programs that the City uses to procure products and services. Court fines are payable in person, through the mail and via online-services. Please note that youth offenders are not subject to paying on-line or through the mail. Cashier's check, credit card or money orders are acceptable forms of payment. The Court does not accept personal checks.

HOW TO PAY MONTHLY WATER BILL

Monthly water bills are payable in person, through automatic bank drafting, through the mail, drop box at city hall, over the phone and via online-services. Acceptable

forms of payment are cash, check, credit/debit card (Visa or MasterCard) or money order.
