WORKSHOP BUSINESS

Discuss the City of Alvin Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ).

Ron Cox with Ron Cox Consulting was present to discuss potential issues and future considerations for the City of Alvin's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction areas. Mayor explained that there needs to be a clear understanding of Alvin's ETJ areas and what should be the next steps moving forward. The potential issues related to the area referred to as the Strip, and the several incorporated cities located within the ETJ were discussed. The legal concerns will be forwarded to the City Attorney for review and advisement. Council conferred about the benefits and drawbacks of releasing or retaining portions of land and the possible value of swapping territories. Current considerations to be pursed are that staff will work with other cities to eliminate conflicts, possible releasing portions of the ETJ to the county and the possibility of trading others. Future considerations will focus on legalities and realities of modifying the Strip.
