ORDINANCE NO. 22-O

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ALVIN, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 13, ITINERANT MERCHANTS AND VENDORS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ALVIN, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING SECTION 13-1 DEFINITIONS, AND SECTION 13-21 EXEMPTIONS TO DISTANCE AND/OR RESTRICTED LOCATIONS SET FORTH IN SECTIONS 13-16 AND 13-18 AND/OR EXCEPTIONS TO REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND SETTING FORTH OTHER PROVISIONS RELATED THERETO.

Section 3. Penalties. Any person, firm, entity or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance, as it exists or may be emended, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$500. Each continuing day's violation shall constitute a separate offence.
