

RESOLUTION 22-R-17

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALVIN, TEXAS, ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF A FREIGHT TRAIN CABOOSE FROM ISO-TEX DIAGNOSTICS, INC., TO THE CITY OF ALVIN FOR PUBLIC DISPLAY.

WHEREAS, the City of Alvin is seeking to beautify property located at the corner of North Gordon Street and Willis Street, commonly known as the “Ugly Corner,” and

WHEREAS, Megan Maloney, the President of Iso-Tex Diagnostics, Inc., has indicated her intent to donate a freight train caboose for the City to display at the Ugly Corner; and

WHEREAS, this donation is being made in light of the City’s longstanding association with trains, and to assist the beautification of the Ugly Corner near the Alvin Train Depot; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alvin welcomes support from the community in attempts to beautify and enhance City property; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to accept this donation and express their appreciation to Megan Maloney and Iso-Tex Diagnostics, Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALVIN, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the City Council hereby adopts the recitals and findings set forth in the preamble hereof.

Section 2. That the City Council, on behalf of the citizens of the City of Alvin, Texas, hereby expresses their appreciation to Megan Maloney and Iso-Tex Diagnostics, Inc. and accepts the donation of the freight train caboose to be displayed by the City of Alvin on the Ugly Corner or near the Alvin Train Depot.

Section 3. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meeting Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.
