**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF LEGISLATION TO DESIGNATE A  
PORTION OF FM 1462 AS THE LIEUTENANT COLONEL ROY LIN  
TISDALE MEMORIAL HIGHWAY**

**WHEREAS**, HB 947 has been filed by Representative Ed Thompson in the 85th Texas Legislative Session; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposal will designate a portion of Farm-to-Market Road 1462 in Brazoria County as the Lieutenant Colonel Roy Lin Tisdale Memorial Highway; and

**WHEREAS**, Lt. Col. Tisdale was an Alvin native and highly decorated Veteran looking forward to retiring in the Lone Star State; and

**WHEREAS**, Lt. Col. Tisdale was commissioned by the United States Army in 1993; and

**WHEREAS**, Lt. Col. Tisdale served two full tours in Iraq and two full tours in Afghanistan; and

**WHEREAS**, Lt. Col. Tisdale was commander of the 525th Brigade Special Troops Battalion, 525th Battlefield Surveillance Brigade; and

**WHEREAS**, at age 42, Lt. Col. Tisdale was killed in a shooting at Fort Bragg in North Carolina on June 28, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, Lt. Col. Tisdale is survived by his wife of 19 years, Kim Tisdale, and his two children, Megan and Lane; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposal would be a fitting tribute to honor the life and service of Lt. Col. Tisdale;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Alvin supports the proposed legislation to designate a portion of FM 1462 as the Lieutenant Colonel Roy Lin Tisdale Memorial Highway.
