

RESOLUTION 20-R-31

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALVIN, TEXAS, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF ALVIN, TEXAS, A PROPOSITION TO VOTE FOR OR AGAINST THE “ADOPTION OF THE FIRE FIGHTERS’ AND POLICE OFFICERS’ CIVIL SERVICE LAW, APPLICABLE TO ONLY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT;” AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS THERETO.

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2020, a Special Election was held in the City of Alvin, Texas, for the purpose of voting “for” or “against” a proposition for the “Adoption of the fire fighters’ and police officer’s civil service law, applicable to only the police department;” and

WHEREAS, the said election was duly and legally held in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of said election have been verified and returned by the proper judges and clerks; and

WHEREAS, there are currently 15,158 registered voters in the City of Alvin.

WHEREAS, a total of 9,344 voters voted in such election; and

WHEREAS, the governing body as the canvassing authority of the City of Alvin, Texas, canvassed said returns on Tuesday November 17, 2020, and hereby declare the result of such Special Election for public record;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALVIN, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts set forth the in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Section 2. The official canvass of the returns of the Special Election held on November 3, 2020, reflect that the following proposition received the number of votes as dictated below:

Proposition 1
“For” or “Against”

“Adoption of the fire fighters’ and police officer’s civil service law, applicable to only the police department.”

Against	1,761	19%
Undervotes	1,506	16%
Total Votes	9,344	100%

Section 3. In accordance with the official canvass of the returns of the Special Election held on November 3, 2020, the following proposition was elected as shown:


The Municipal Civil Service for Police Officers under Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 143, applicable to the City of Alvin Police Department.

Section 5. Open Meetings Act. It is hereby officially found and determined that this meeting was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.
